Current Building Challenges	New Building
Not enough space (6K sq ft)	15-20K sq ft
<p>Access into building – requires steps</p> <p><i>Difficult to move large amounts of donations</i></p>	<p>Ground level access</p> <p>A dock or garage door</p> <p>Able to accept large donations that come on pallets – something we can't do today</p>
<p>Outside donation drop-off area</p> <p><i>To sort/move heavy carts full of donations from outside to inside especially difficult during bad weather</i></p>	<p>Donation area located inside building, under cover</p>
<p>Food pick-up lane</p> <p><i>Uncovered, rain/snow a challenge</i></p> <p><i>Difficult to get line of cars in/out safely</i></p>	<p>Covered area for food loading</p> <p>2 lanes vs 1</p> <p>Drive-through vs turn-around</p>
<p>Storage capacity</p> <p><i>Not enough, requires storing some things too high on shelves or off-site</i></p>	<p>3 x's current storage space</p> <p>Appropriate heights of storage units for safety</p>
<p>Lobby/client check-in area too small</p> <p><i>Clients often must wait outside</i></p> <p><i>Lacks privacy</i></p>	<p>3 x's current space, room for all</p> <p>Private client intake stations</p>

Room for additional clothing racks and freezers to be able to accept more donations at one time
